NSCV Part E consultation — Operational practices

Issued 27 September 2010

Background

The National Standard for Commercial Vessels (NSCV) Part E - Operational Practices is being amended to include a new Annex F which specifies factors that need to be considered when determining appropriate crew for a ship.

The National Marine Safety Committee (NMSC) has released a draft on the proposed changes for public comment. The period for public comment closes on 15 November 2010.

Following this period of consultation, a revised draft of Part E will be sent to the Australian Transport Council (ATC) for approval. Once approved, the amended Part E will take effect immediately in Queensland.
