## Conversion of pre Uniform Shipping Laws (USL) Code licences

#### **Background**

Commercial and fishing ship licences that were issued in Queensland before the enactment of the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Act 1994* ceased to be valid from 1996. Maritime Safety Queensland (MSQ) still receives requests to recognise these licences and will update them to current licences according to the tables in this Marine Information Bulletin.

This information has previously been released as *Notes* for the Guidance of Candidates for the conversion of licences for the specific periods of time.

Licences issued prior to the introduction of the USL Code before 1988, will be converted according to Table 1. Licences issued between 1988 and 1992 will be converted according to Table 2. Licences issued between 1992 and 1994 will be converted according to Table 3.

#### **Application**

To apply to have your licence converted, you must do the following:

- Lodge an application form (F3103) personally at a Maritime Safety Queensland regional office.
- Provide the original licence (or statutory declaration if lost).
- Provide two recent colour passport photographs (taken within the last year).
- Pay the prescribed fee.
- Provide statements of attainment attesting to the successful completion of current Senior First Aid (TDMMF1007B) and Elements of Shipboard Safety (TDMMF5407A, TDMMF5507A and TDMMF1107B) units of competency from the Transport Distribution (Maritime Operations) training package, OR evidence of completion of previously approved Elements of Shipboard Safety or Workplace Health & Safety at Sea modules. These units of competency are held in perpetuity.
- Provide a current certificate of medical fitness (issued within the last two years), including an eyesight test (where required) as defined in Medical Fitness Requirements (USL Schedule 1).

- Provide proof of a Marine Radio Operators Certificate of Proficiency (deck certificates only).
- Candidates are required to demonstrate currency of competence by providing evidence of 12 months of sea service appropriate to the class of licence held within the past five years.
- Successfully complete a MSQ independent assessment at a Maritime Safety Queensland regional office.
